Casajus Antiguos Vinedos 2011 is produced from grapes grown on more than 90 year old vines and aged for 3 years in new French and American oak casks. The wine has a bright violet color and deeply pitched spice accented black and blue fruit aromas that show excellent clarity and pick up sexy incense, vanilla, and floral qualities in the glass. The intense boysenberry and cherry vanilla flavors show a suave, seamless texture. The vanilla and spice notes tenaciously continue through the finish, which is framed by smooth, harmonious tannins.

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
