Xabec 2011 is produced from carinena and garnacha and aged for 15 months in new French, American, and Hungarian oak casks. Deep ruby color. The bouquet displays vibrant scents of fresh red berries, cherry skin, lavender, and peppery spices, with a smoky oak nuance that gains power as the wine breaths in the glass. The palate is snappy and focused, offering bitter cherry and spice cake flavors that increase in the glass. The lavender notes continue through the energetic fruity finish. ISSUE 176 SEPT/OCT 2014

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
